About the Project

The participants come from 6 different NGOs in 6 different countries: Portugal, Romania, Spain, Greece, Slovenia and Italy.

MAIN GOAL: Promoting the active participation and empowerment of young people through an intercultural project on climate change and renewable energies.

Dates

The Youth Exchange is going to happen in Lamego (Portugal) from 14th of November to 19th of November 2023, with 6 participants + 1 Group Leader from each organization. In total, there will be 42 participants!

Profile of the participants


GROUP LEADER: Each country needs to have 1 Group Leader, and this person should be someone with 18 or more years. This person should also have:

- a high sense of responsibility, be used to deal with young people, social inclusion, diversity and culture;
- experience in working with non-formal education;
- knowledge of this Erasmus+ program and be sensitized about social exclusion, especially in young people.

PARTICIPANTS: Each country must choose 6 young people in total. They should:

- be from 16 to 30 years old;
- be interested in this project's themes;
- be a good communicator, have responsibility and proactivity and be interested in Erasmus+ programs and so recognize the value of being part of a project like this one.


The Porto (OPORTO) airport is the closest one to Lamego, so please land in this one. Please contact us (<u>ordincea@gmail.com</u>) with the whole planned itinerary, before buying any ticket. We have to approve the tickets, otherwise we might not reimburse the money you spent.

Green Travel

Traveling has a significant influence on the environment, which should make us think about more ecological solutions. Opting for Green Travel is a good opportunity to prioritize ecologically friendly means of transport, such as trains or buses, for the majority of your journey. If you want to embark on this way of traveling, reach out to us and/or your organization to help you in this. By embracing green travel practices, you can extend travel days reimbursements and even accommodations in cities where transport transitions are necessary.

Getting to Lamego

Here's a little diagram showing you two different ways to get to Lamego! in the sections below you can find the timetables and some more specific information about each means of transport.



METRO

1. Once you arrive at the airport, try to follow the directions to the subway station and search for this symbol:



- 2. Buy your ticket at the machines: choose the Z4 option (4 zones), for around $2,15 \in$;
- 3. You'll take the Fine towards TRINDADE. Get out at the SENHORA DA HORA stop (7

stops; +/- 14 min);

4. In SENHORA DA HORA you can take any of these lines to get off at CAMPANHÃ

towards CAMPANHÃ towards FÂNZERES towards ESTÁDIO DO DRAGÃO

(+/- 12 stops, 20 min)

5. You should get out in CAMPANHÃ, and follow the directions to the train station or to the bus station.

Option 1: BUS

When in Campanhã go to the terminal intermodal of Campanhã, there you can go to the ticket offices and buy your ticket, or you can do it online. If you choose to buy online, don't forget to have your ID with you, you'll need to show it on the bus. Buy the tickets to Lamego, with the price 9,80€. We highly recommend you buy the ticket in advance. The travel duration is between 2h to 3h.

Option 2: TRAIN

When in CAMPANHÃ, go to the ticket offices or you can buy your ticket online. If you choose to buy online, don't forget to have your ID with you, you'll need to show it on the train. Buy the tickets to Régua, with the prices $8,95 \in$ or $9,85 \in$.

The travel duration is about 2h.

When in RÉGUA go to the bus stop.

The bus stop is right in front of the train station, just keep going straight ahead and cross over to the other side of the road (don't forget to use the pedestrian crossing!). You'll see several buses stopped so just look for the one that says Lamego. You can buy your ticket on the bus, but it's important that you bring some money with you, the price of the ticket is €0.90.

Here's a little piece of advice: when you get on the bus, show the driver the stop you want to get off at in Lamego. Here you have two options: Avenida 5 de Outubro (the Hotel is right in front of the bus stop) ou Central de Camionagem (the Hotel is 10 min by feet)

BY CAR

If you want, you can take a taxi from the airport to Lamego, the trip will take around 1h30 and it will be approximately 140€. (Note: there are always some taxi drivers who don't do these kinds of longer journeys to other cities. We will only reimburse you for this trip if you are travelling in a group (minimum of 4 people) and if you don't have any other transport options, so please have this in mind)

Refunds

The travel reimburses will be based on real costs, considering the following limits (value per person):

NOTE: This value is the total value for the YE, so you should subtract the money you need for the other transports besides the airplane (if applicable). Subtract around $40-50 \in$ to the total price in order to obtain the value for the flight.

Also, if you use the Green Travel, you can have +37€ per travel day (with a maximum of 4 days).

Contact us before buying any ticket, if you buy it without our approval, we might not reimburse the money you spent.

Important:

• The refunds will be made after the end of the YE. In order to do that, each person must keep every receipt (airplane, metro, bus and train) and send it to us (**ordincea@gmail.com**) or give them in hand. Without the receipts/tickets we won't be able to refund you.

Weather

In November, the weather is relatively cold. The average maximum is 13°C and the average minimum is 7°C. Sometimes the temperature can reach negative values, so bring warm clothes as well as waterproof jacket and footwear.
